Call to Order: Town Council President Keith E. Macksoud called the joint meeting of Lincoln Town Council with Lincoln Water Commission to order at 4:33 p.m. on Tuesday January 13, 2026.

1. Special Meeting

a. Source Water Assessment – Presentation

- Presentation from the Water Commission on Source Water Assessment.
- Town Council President Keith E. Macksoud relayed to turn in over to Chairman Ken Booth to discuss what they are going to hear tonight.
- Chairman Ken Booth expressed the purpose of this meeting is to relay from last year of the issue that came up of the Water Source Assessment.
- On certain days, water demand in the system reached maximum capacity, indicating a need to consider additional supply.
- Following that process, they solicited engineering proposals for the award of Source Water Assessment Project to Pare Engineering to assess certain values.
- Pare Engineering undertook the project and Assistant Superintendent Lewis Prescott III and Chairman Ken Booth meet with them a couple of times.
- The process is to make sure what is going on and this is the final draft on a report.
- Tonight, they will run it to a general level, there is a written document they will be no modification, and he will supply them with documents as to why the value of categories.
- This will be a long presentation, but they can discuss it, and he can bring some guidance.
- Chairman Ken Booth relay he will follow up on January 14, 2026, they have the Water Commission's meeting at the Town Hall to address the commission's member.
- They will set a date to have a separate meeting just to discuss this and he anticipates having a couple of days before a decision is made.
